VISION STATEMENT

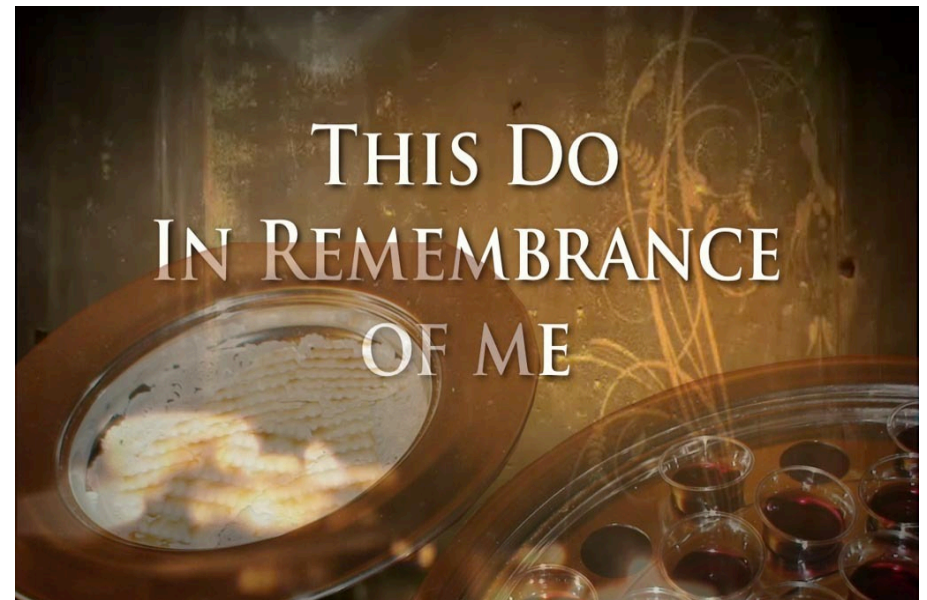
The vision of Peak City is to remain approachable, visible, and accessible to work the work of Christ. **WE ARE** the city that cannot be hid.

CHURCH HISTORY

Peak City Full Gospel Baptist Church was forged by God and founded by Pastor JT and Evangelist Lakithia Chapman on May 1, 2016. The first worship service was held at the Apex Community Center 53 Hunter Street Apex, NC. Over 150 persons gathered to share in this new worship effort. Dr. John T Chapman preached the first sermon at Peak City FGBC entitled, "Let the Healing Begin." A reflection of God's favor, the first worship service was adorned with uplifting praise and worship, attentive ushers, melodies from the Peak City Choir concluding with worshipers partaking of the Lord's Supper. After the first worship service ended, the gatherers visited a 10,000 plus square foot property located at 1701 Center Street in Apex NC. A week later, this location would become the first home of Peak City Full Gospel Baptist Church. While new members worked diligently on the renovations of the new property, worship was conducted at the Hilton Garden Inn on Columbus Drive in Cary NC. The first worship service in the new edifice was held on May 22nd, 2016. The attendance and excitement continues to grow with each passing week. The church considers this new ministry as the Lord's doing. To God be the Glory for the things He has done. The best is yet to come!

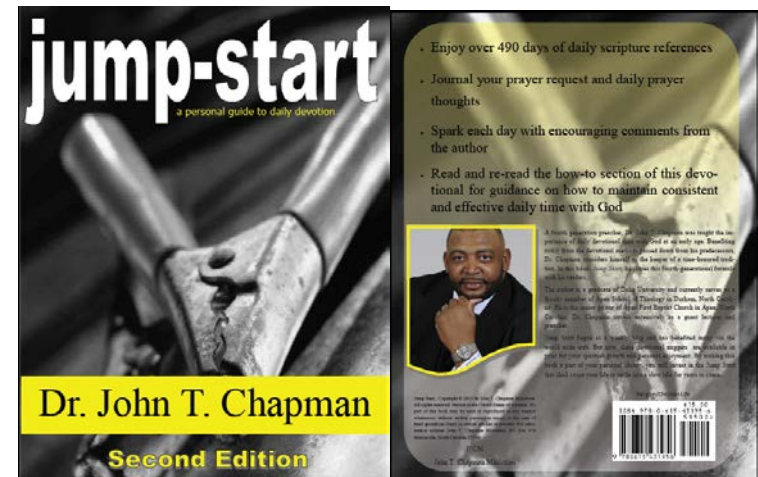

Thank You for Sending Encouragement! (KJV)

As a pastor, it is easy to become detached from doing the "work of the ministry" and actually appreciating the benefits of it. It was during my personal time of crisis that I gained a fresh appreciation of the encouragement that comes through the saints. However, it is important that we don't forget Who is actually sending the help. God is the facilitator-or should I say-the Originator of encouragement. So while we thank God for sending the preacher and the saints to bring encouragement, I think the best idea is to thank God Himself. Have you ever been down and received a word, song, person or persons who brought some form of relief from the pressure? That is the Lord's doing. Let us thank Him this week for sending encouragement. It doesn't matter who or how He provides it, let us only thank Him because He provides it. While you are reading this week, keep your focus on the subject: Thank You for Sending Encouragement! Enjoy your reading and stay encouraged.

Monday: Psalm 61: 1-8

1Hear my cry, O God; attend unto my prayer.

2From the end of the earth will I cry unto thee, when my heart is overwhelmed: lead me to the rock that is higher than I.

3For thou hast been a shelter for me, and a strong tower from the enemy.

4I will abide in thy tabernacle for ever: I will trust in the covert of thy wings. Selah.

5For thou, O God, hast heard my vows: thou hast given me the heritage of those that fear thy name.

6Thou wilt prolong the king's life: and his years as many generations. indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.

7He shall abide before God for ever: O prepare mercy and truth, which may preserve him.

8So will I sing praise unto thy name for ever, that I may daily perform my vows.

Tuesday: Psalm 62: 1-8

1Truly my soul waiteth upon God: from him cometh my salvation.

2He only is my rock and my salvation; he is my defence; I shall not be greatly moved.

3How long will ye imagine mischief against a man? ye shall be slain all of you: as a bowing wall shall ye be, and as a tottering fence.

4They only consult to cast him down from his excellency: they delight in lies: they bless with their mouth, but they curse inwardly. Selah.

5My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from him.

6He only is my rock and my salvation: he is my defence; I shall not be moved.

7In God is my salvation and my glory: the rock of my strength, and my refuge, is in God.

8Trust in him at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before him: God is a refuge for us. Selah.
